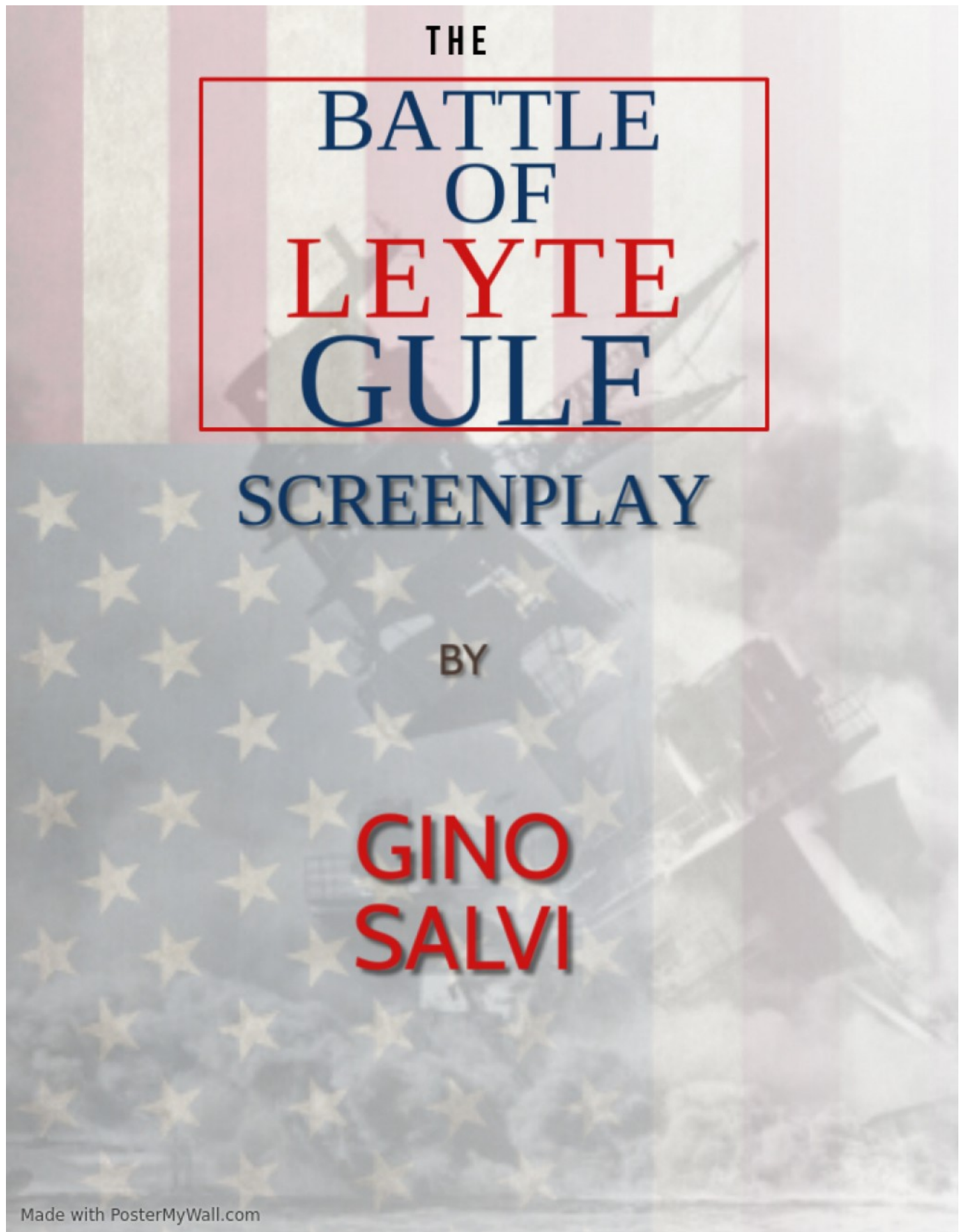


"The Battle of Leyte Gulf" a screenplay by Gino Salvi
