There is help beyond borders and barriers, [Airfunding](https://www.airfunding.net) has over 10,000,000 supporters around the world and can be accessed in 200+ countries. Airfunding is free to use, anyone can register and start creating projects in less than 5 minutes.

A recent and ongoing project to help COVID-19 in Cebu city has already raised **\$ 2,646** as of November 5, 2020, and is still gathering more support from people all over the world. One of the most successful projects is from Wahyu Bagus Setiadi, a person living in West Sumatra, Indonesia who needs to raise funds for his Cranioplasty surgery. Up to date, he has gathered **\$8,652** donations to fund his surgery. Airfunding is a global donation-type crowdfunding platform that allows people not only to open projects but also to donate and to share on Social Media Networks to be able to also help.

With the current world situation, where many people are in dire need of support, Airfunding has bridged the gap of barriers so that everyone can help everyone. Now people can seek help and provide support to almost anyone in the world.
