The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

A Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation (RPVI), he is a member of the Society of Vascular Surgery and a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS).

Vascular surgery is a surgical subspecialty in which diseases of the vascular system, including the arteries, veins, and lymphatic circulation, are managed by medical therapy, minimally-invasive catheter procedures, and surgical reconstruction. A vascular surgeon diagnoses, treats, and manages conditions in the arteries and veins, also called the blood vessels. These specialists treat a range of health problems, from spider and varicose veins to life-threatening aneurysms, and can help patients manage chronic conditions throughout their lives.

A leader in his field, Dr. Correa is internationally published in myriad journals on a variety of vascular surgery topics. He has received numerous awards, including Best Surgery Resident at Saint Louis University and was nominated for the Most Caring Physician award at Saint Louis University Hospital.

On a more personal note, he is a former professional tennis player who was once Ecuador's top-ranked 18-and-under player and even invited to play for the Davis Cup team of Ecuador.
