Delta Zeta Delta brings women from all walks of life together to create opportunities for networking, philanthropy, fellowship, and so much more. Delta Zeta Delta also offers scholarships for members and has created a fund for its sisters in the event they have emergency situations in life and have no place else to turn. Delta Zeta Delta's founder says, "We don't just call each other sisters.....We really are sisters and we will forever keep it that way!"

Delta Zeta Delta welcomes currently enrolled students and alumnae at traditional or online universities and colleges, trade schools, or any other higher education program. Tennent states, "Before Delta Zeta Delta, women in cosmetology, technical schools, etc. did not have the opportunity to become a member of a sorority. We are changing the way people look at sororities in a major way!"

Since the creation of Delta Zeta Delta in September 2020, the sorority currently has over 100 members across the United States and is growing.
