In 2008, she graduated with her medical degree from Ross University School of Medicine. Three years later, in 2011, she completed her residency in internal medicine at the Medical Center of Central Georgia, finishing top of her residency class.

That same year, she attained board certification in internal medicine through the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

When asked what is her favorite thing about her job, Dr. Beaulieu answered: "The impact that I actually have on others is the best feeling in the world. As a physician, you actually get to help someone feel better, you help diagnose and treat diseases and ultimately can change someone's life just by educating them on making better decisions."

Hospital medicine is a medical specialty that exists in some countries as a branch of internal or family medicine, dealing with the care of acutely ill hospitalized patients. Physicians whose primary professional focus is caring for hospitalized patients only while they are in the hospital are called hospitalists.

A business entrepreneur, Dr. Beaulieu also wrote the book "Paging Doctor You: A Step-by-Step Guide to Becoming a Doctor" as a way to reach back and extend her hand to pull more aspiring doctors forward. She's making it her mission and her duty to clear a path for those coming up behind her. Her goal is to share her journey, help set expectations, and provide guidance and direction to anyone who's thinking of becoming a doctor from high school students to college students and beyond.
