This is derived from the patients own blood which stimulates healing naturally relieving pain and resulting in a speedier recovery.

Advanced complicated shoulder arthroscopic procedures are performed by Dr Okamura using the latest technology and techniques that provide better results with less complications.

Hip disorders are common in people resulting in pain and immobility. Hip pain can present as groin pain and even low back pain. Arthroscopic Hip Surgery is a newer method of treating patients with hip pains. It is an advanced procedure and not offered to patients by most orthopedic surgeons. Dr Okamura is able to provide an alternative to just living with their pain until they require a total hip replacement. He is skilled in performing complicated arthroscopic hip surgery to address pain and stiffness. Dr Okamura is like an artist who can sculpt the hip to make the ball spherical again to fit into the socket. When the tissues stabilizing the hip are insufficient Dr Okamura can perform complicated procedures to reconstruct it. This allows patients to relieve their pain, increase their mobility and restore their health. Patients ultimately regain control of their lives.

Utilizing the latest advancements in surgical techniques, Honolulu Sports & Spine Surgery Center is dedicated to providing high quality outpatient surgical care in a convenient and comfortable setting.
