The primary source of medical care in Nassau County since 1935, Nassau University Medical Center is a public teaching hospital affiliated with the Health Sciences Center of Stony Brook University & Northwell Health. Academically, Katie graduated with her Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree with Highest Distinction from Suffolk County Community College in 2005. She then went on to earn her Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from Stony Brook School of Nursing in 2012, followed by her Master of Science in Nurse Anesthesia degree from the University of New England in 2015.

From 2018 until 2019, she served as a certified registered nurse anesthetist at Brookdale Hospital Medical Center.

In good standing with a number of professional organizations, Katie is a member of the Golden Key International Honor Society, the Sigma Theta Tau International Nursing Honor Society, the Oncology Nursing Society, the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists, and the American Association of Critical-Care Nurses.

Attributing her success to her drive and her desire to be in the medical field, she holds certifications in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), Basic Life Support (BLS - not intended for postnominal use), Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS), Certified Critical Care Nurse (CCCN), and Oncology Certified Nurse (OCN).
