How this app's changing long distance communication

The principle of the application is very simple: when at some time of the day you think of your partner, you launch Tinkovu to send them a Tink, a simple notification informing them that you are thinking of him. Tinks can also be photos, drawings, or even vocals. The idea is to make this notification an exceptional moment of the day, a time when you will feel less alone and closer to your partner. Almost 5,000 Tinks are traded every day. To get to know your couple better and to spend time together despite the distance, Tinkovu offers Couple Goals, multiplechoice questionnaires where partners have to guess their mutual answers. More than 120 questionnaires are available and new ones are added regularly. Users can also create their own questions and answers. Planned developments - With more than 45,000 accounts and nearly 2,000 daily users, the objective of the application is now to export internationally, to offer more and more entertaining content for couples around the world. The addition and regular renewal of Couple Goals are also one of the objectives for the coming years.
