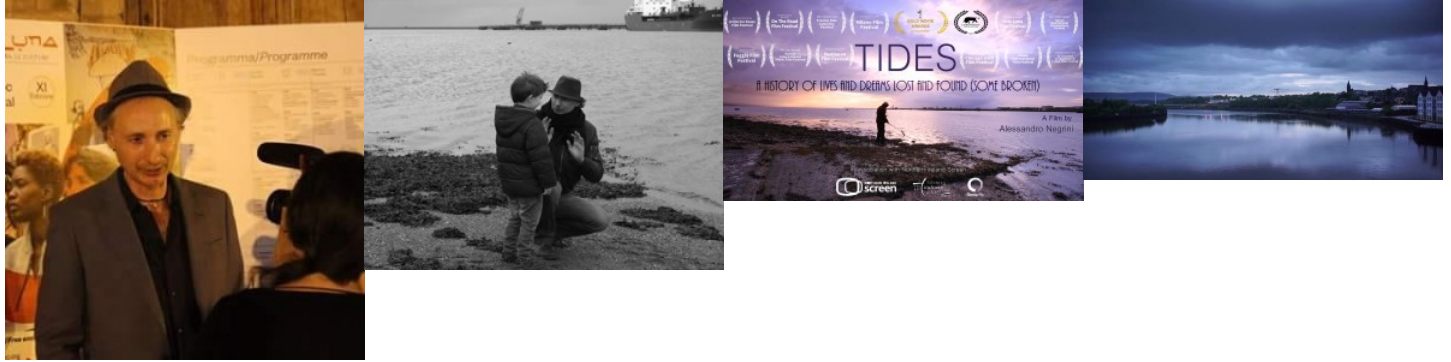

The film, defined by critics as "docudream" because of its dreamlike, magical atmosphere, melting documentary genre and surrealism, won an incredible raft of awards around the world and tells the story of the majestic River Foyle in Derry. The film is directed by Derry based Italian director Alessandro Negrini, who previously directed the multi-award-winning film Paradiso about the Fountain estate.

Dop is renowned Norwegian Oddgeir Saether (Dop in David Lynch's Inland Empire), editor Belfast based Stuart Sloan.

Recently, Negrini has been selected by one of the most prominent Italian film critic, Adriano Aprà, as part of 'Fuorinorma' (Out of the Norm), a project and a book selecting the best New Italian experimental cinema of the last 15 years.
