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With a broad educational medical background, Dr. Lin-Hurtubise graduated from Creighton University School of Medicine in 1991 at Omaha, NE, and pursued an internship plus residency in general surgery at the University of Connecticut Health Center - J Dempsey Hospital and Providence Hospital & Medical Centers, Southfield, MI, finishing in 1996, followed by a research fellowship (Lynch Syndrome) at Creighton University Medical Center and attending-staff initial work experience at Doctor's Regional Medical Center in SE Missouri, concluding with an additional year of postgraduate clinical training in surgical oncology at the University of Missouri-Columbia/Ellis Fischel Cancer Center in 2000.

Dedicated to surgical excellence, the doctor is board-certified in surgery by the American Board of Surgery (ABS). The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Furthering his professional development, Dr. Lin-Hurtubise is a current Fellow of the American College of Surgeons and a Fellow of the Society of Surgical Oncology.

General surgery is a surgical specialty that focuses on abdominal contents including the esophagus, stomach, small bowel, colon, liver, pancreas, bile ducts, gallbladder, spleen, appendix, and often the breast, thyroid, and adrenal glands. A general surgeon (surgical oncologist) performs a wide range of surgeries for many forms of upper/lower intestinal, breast, skin, and soft tissue neoplasms. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery all the way to outpatient care.
