


Kyle Chapman, MD, a Pulmonologist with WVU Medicine

The Cystic Fibrosis Center is West Virginia's only accredited cystic fibrosis center serving both children and adults, with the largest CF-specialized team in the region. The experienced team of specialists is actively involved in national research and quality improvement efforts. All of them are specially trained and experienced in treating and managing CF and supporting patients and families.

Bringing outstanding clinical care and groundbreaking research to West Virginia and the surrounding region, the Cystic Fibrosis Center treats and manages CF and related conditions and complications. These can include CF-related diabetes; depression, anxiety, and other mental health issues that can result from a chronic disease; gastrointestinal problems; and pulmonary infections, including atypical mycobacterial infections.

Before embarking on his professional journey, Dr. Chapman graduated with his medical degree from the West Virginia University School of Medicine in 2013. He then went on to perform his residency in internal medicine and his fellowship in pulmonary and critical care medicine at West Virginia University.

With an unwavering commitment to his specialty, the doctor is board-certified in internal medicine, pulmonary disease, and critical care medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Holding an academic role, Dr. Chapman serves as an Assistant Professor of Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine at the West Virginia University School of Medicine.

Pulmonology is a medical specialty that deals with diseases involving the respiratory tract. A pulmonologist is an internal medicine physician who specializes in preventing, diagnosing, and treating conditions and diseases that affect the lungs, bronchial tubes, and the respiratory system, including the nose, pharynx, and throat.
