Leawo Officially Released UHD Drive Tool V1.0.0.0 to Help Downgrade UHD Drives for Playback, Conversion and Backup

Leawo Software just dropped out the first version of UHD Drive Tool. The UHD Drive Tool V1.0.0.0 could help downgrade firmware of UHD drives so as to help people smoothly play back, convert and back up 4K/UHD Blu-ray discs.

With 4K televisions and monitors going completely mainstream at multiple price points and feature levels, more and more movie fans have purchased 4K/UHD Blu-ray discs to get a UHD movie experience at home. However, problems arise along with the wide-spreading of 4K/UHD Blu-ray discs. UHD drive incompatible with 4K/UHD Blu-ray discs has been more and more mentioned. The incompatibility issue of UHD drive and UHD discs has prevented people from playing, converting and copying UHD discs. Therefore, solutions to make UHD drive work with 4K/UHD Blu-ray discs has been widely mentioned. Leawo's UHD Drive Tool is designed and developed for such cases.

Leawo UHD Drive Tool enables people to downgrade UHD-unfriendly firmware on Blu-ray drive to a compatible version for 4K UHD Blu-ray ripping, copying or playing via certain programs, like <u>Leawo Blu-ray Ripper</u>, <u>Leawo Blu-ray Copy</u> and <u>Leawo Blu-ray Player</u>. The workflow of the Leawo UHD Drive Tool is quite simple: detect the original UHD drive firmware and recognize its version, and then list all available firmware for customers to choose for downloading and downgrading. Customers could downgrade (or sometimes upgrade) the firmware of UHD drive to any version that is compatible with UHD discs.

Leawo UHD Drive Tool now is compatible with nearly all internal 4K Blu-ray drives with SATA interface, external 4K Blu-ray drives and external USB drives. It could downgrade UHD drives developed by ASUS, LG, and other manufacturers, covering all the UHD drives in the market. By downgrading these UHD drives, people could then freely play, rip, convert or copy UHD discs without any restriction.

To make Leawo UHD Drive work smoothly, the computer should run on Windows 7 or later, at least 2GB RAM, 10+GB free hard disk space, Core 2 Quard or above processor, and Internet connection. Without an Internet connection, this program would not work.

Price and Availability

Currently, Leawo UHD Drive Tool V1.0.0.0 is only available for Windows 7/8/8.1/10 users. It's available in both free trial and registered versions, both of which are free to download and install. The free trial version can download target firmware but won't be able to install target firmware for UHD drive, while the registered version has no limit. The registered version is available with 2 different pricing tags: \$59.97 for a 1-year license and \$65.97 for a lifetime license, 40% off the original pricing.
