<u>Perri Sansi</u> The only case in which sealants are not effective is when a dental crown or implant is present. Dentists do not recommend sealants for infant molars that have significant grooves or pits, though.

Tooth sealing is suitable for babies who have a deep depression or groove. Dentist: If a child's baby teeth have deep depressions or grooves, dental sealants are suitable for them. If the baby's tooth has deep depressions or groves, the dentist recommends dental sealants. Tooth sealing can also be used for placing crowns or implants on baby jaws.

Most dentists recommend sealing the first molar with a set of sealants for about 6-7 years. Some dentists only apply sealants to adult molars and teeth, others recommend applying sealants to baby teeth.

<u>Pardip Sansi</u> Sealants can protect teeth from decay for up to 10 years but must be checked for chipping and wear during regular dental examinations. To ensure that the sealants are preserved, you should examine them for any cracks during regular visits to the dentist.

Sealants are best placed on the surface of the teeth, such as in the mouth, jaw joint, or under the tongue. This is to ensure that they can be applied smoothly and that no bacteria are trapped in the sealant. A dried tooth should be present so that the sealant covers all surfaces on your surface completely and evenly.

<u>Perri Sansi</u> Sealants protect your teeth: Sealants are a protective layer that is painted to seal cavities that tend to grooves and cracks.

They are used on the back of the teeth, which are most at risk of decay and tooth decay. The sealant forms a barrier around the cavity, preventing it from forming in a vulnerable area of the tooth.
