He completed his internship in general surgery at The Mount Sinai Hospital in 1983, followed by residencies at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center and New York-Presbyterian Hospital in 1984 and 1988, respectively. Finally, he completed a fellowship in neuroradiology at New York-Presbyterian Hospital in 1990.

With over four decades of experience in his field, Dr. Sherman is board-certified in diagnostic radiology and neuroradiology by the American Board of Radiology (ABR). The ABR is a not-for-profit physician-led organization that oversees the certification and ongoing professional development of specialists in diagnostic radiology, interventional radiology, radiation oncology, and medical physics.

Furthermore, he is board-certified in nuclear medicine by the American Board of Nuclear Medicine (ABNM), which certifies physicians as specialists in the practice of nuclear medicine. The ABNM is one of the 24 member boards of the American Board of Medical Specialties.

Diagnostic radiology refers to the field of medicine that uses non-invasive imaging scans to diagnose a patient. A diagnostic radiologist is a physician who uses imaging methodologies to diagnose and manage patients and provide therapeutic options.
