Academically, Dr. Singer earned his medical degree at the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto and completed his internship and residency at St. Michael's Hospital in Toronto. He completed research and clinical fellowships in nephrology at Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts.

With over 30 years of experience, the doctor is board-certified in nephrology and internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Among his professional affiliations, Dr. Singer is a member of the American Society of Nephrology, the International Society of Nephrology, the National Kidney Foundation, the Renal Physicians Association, the American College of Physicians, and the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society.

Nephrology is a specialty of medicine and pediatric medicine that concerns itself with the kidneys: the study of normal kidney function and kidney disease, the preservation of kidney health, and the treatment of kidney disease, from diet and medication to renal replacement therapy. A nephrologist is a medical

doctor who specializes in kidney care and treating diseases of the kidneys.

Having authored articles in peer-reviewed journals and co-authored several books, Dr. Singer has lectured on topics related to chronic kidney disease, dialysis, and transplantation, as well as other areas in clinical nephrology. He has also been the recipient of various awards and accolades, including the On-Time Doctor Award (2014, 2015, 2016), Patients' Choice Award (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018), Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2017, 2018), and Patients' Choice 5th Anniversary Award (2020).
