'Invited In' Women Driven Short Film Highlighting Mental Health During the Pandemic Wraps Production Successfully

The team was able to film whilst battling against COVID-19 outbreaks in Hong Kong safely and quickly with a minimized cast and crew.

The film has partnered with clothing brands that were founded by women in Hong Kong. <u>Basics for Basics</u> by Kayla Wong is an ethical clothing company that provides ready-to-wear clothes that adhere to sustainable and fair trade practices. <u>Emma Wallace</u> by Emma Wallace provides ready-to-wear fashionable pieces that deliver a seamless blend of Western and Eastern influences.

Additionally, Invited In has partnered with local mental health organisations such as <u>KELY</u> and <u>MindHK</u> to help spread the message of the film and work with the youth community to begin a deeper conversation regarding the destigmatization of mental health within Hong Kong.

Invited In has headed into its post-production stages with expected completion during the summer of 2021.
