In order to remove the barriers to access NSI Nail products for Berbice Nail Technicians, NSI Nails Guyana is coming to Berbice.

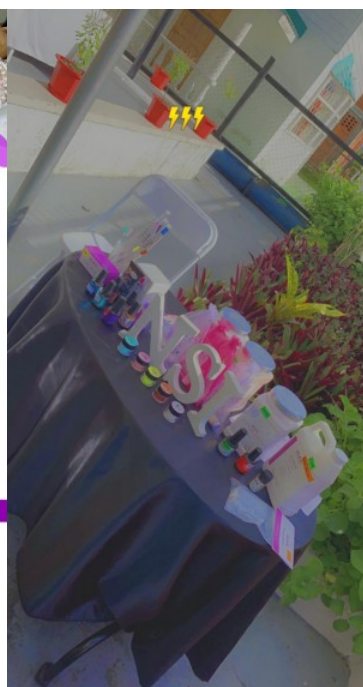
