Dr. Gagne is an expert at performing different types of dental sedation, and in particular IV sedation; since 1991, Dr. Gagne has practiced [Intravenous Sedation](#) and he is now the most experienced IV sedation provider in Ventura County, California. For patients who require general anesthesia, dental anesthesiologists assist in procedures.

At Dr. Gagne's office, dedicated treatment rooms are specially designed to be wheelchair accessible, and are the largest available in the county of Ventura. Anesthesiologists and specialized staff thus have ample room to perform anesthesia and other procedures, as well as bring in all the equipment that is necessary to go along with them.
