He is an active member of such distinguished medical societies, such as the American Osteopathic Association, the North American Spine Society, AO Spine North America, and the HSS Spine Fellowship Alumni Association.

Orthopedic surgery is the branch of surgery concerned with conditions involving the musculoskeletal system. Orthopedic surgeons use both surgical and non-surgical means to treat musculoskeletal trauma, spine diseases, sports injuries, degenerative diseases, infections, tumors, and congenital disorders.

Having engaged in research in orthopedic trauma and spine surgery, Dr. Weinstein has presented his research at regional, national, and international academic meetings around the world, including the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons, the North American Spine Society, and the Israel Spine Society. His research is well received by fellow surgeons and has been incorporated into their operating room practices.
