Her training specializes in comprehensive plastic surgery, including cosmetic and aesthetic, breast reconstruction, body contouring, reconstructive and microsurgery, facial trauma, hand surgery, and a spectrum of non-surgical rejuvenation.

Born at Englewood Hospital and raised in Tenafly, New Jersey, Dr. Ferraiola should have known she was destined for plastic surgery when she was six years old watching Dr. D'Amico sew up her 4-year-old sister's facial laceration. She initially chose a different path and pursued private fine arts training in the visual art studio of Soyoo Park. She earned the NJ Governor of the Arts Scholarship and then worked in the fashion design and fine arts industry for several years before embracing her true calling to bettering human lives.

Pursuing her medical path, she graduated with her medical degree from St. George's University School of Medicine. She then served a five-year residency in general surgery at Wright State University and a residency in plastic surgery at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston.

Dr. D'Amico has served as a mentor and exemplar throughout Dr. Ferraiola's medical training, and she looks forward to serving the cosmetic, plastic, and reconstructive surgical needs of the community.

Both doctor and artist, having an extensive amount of fine arts training helps her become a better doctor using solutions gleaned in a way only by possessing both an artist's and a doctor's eye could.

Professionally, Dr. Ferraiola is an active candidate member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons (ASPS) with appointments to the Legislative Advocacy Committee and Regenerative Medicine Sub-committee. Additionally, she was the first resident selected for the ASPS Essentials of Leadership program, recognizing future leaders of the specialty.

With excellence in cosmetic procedures, she is board-certified in surgery by the American Board of Surgery (ABS). The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Plastic surgery is a surgical specialty involving the restoration, reconstruction, or alteration of the human body. It can be divided into two main categories - reconstructive surgery and cosmetic surgery. A plastic surgeon's primary responsibility is performing surgical and non-surgical procedures, and they use a variety of reparative and reconstructive techniques to get the job done.
