Mahmood Khanliving in Australia has become the first Pakistani artist ever to crack the US world music radio stations. He arrived in Australia in 2007 to study at the Sydney Film School and ended up filming a live album at the Sydney Opera House. He is widely regarded as the first Asian-born performer to reach the top of the classical music billboard charts. His commitment to the music industry is unforgettable; therefore, Australia bestowed citizenship upon him after the release of his album 'Like the River,' which was performed live at the Sydney Opera House and subsequently reached number one on the Aria pop charts. He is the first Asian artist to have played at the Sydney Opera House, and his groundbreaking, skillful singing career includes timeless collaborations with Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan. The Pak-singer released the debut solo album that sold over 6 million copies, making him Australia's most prominent Asian singer.

He understands the unpleasant situation that is making everyone's heart heavy. He delivers a beautiful and nostalgic lyrical composition 'Ginoo' with a sheer contrast of classical tunes daubed in the graceful jazz symphonies.
