
Needle Felting - The Easy Craft That You Must Try

Needle Felting - What Is This Craft?

This art or practice helps you transform wool into 3D objects with the use of a needle. These objects can be used for decor and gifting.

You are already aware of the idea if you have practiced a little agitation of wool before. It's only a little different that instead of knitting you are now using a needle in the project. With the extra sharp needle, you are bringing the wool bonds together to create surprising shapes in 3D.

Here's everything that you will need during the practice:

Wool

You cannot put this art to your practice without a special type of wool called roving. Other forms that you can use include batting and we will use roving that is taken from a larger piece and will now help you work through a new project.

A Felting Surface

The practice can take time and even hurt your fingers if you are not careful. Hence, you will need a base to perform the activity and avoid any parts of your body. The surfaces must be spongy and the best ones that will work for it are foam blocks. They are just meant for this practice.

Felting Needle

This isn't a regular needle but a special one, which is created for the art only. It is much sharper than the regular tapestry or sewing needles. Its barbed blades are designed in a manner that helps you agitate

the wool and mold it into special shapes.

How To Bring It To Practice

The only way to become an expert at any craft is to practice it often. When you are making something you look for the different techniques that are specially meant for that shape. The practice to poke your needle and start using it for creating different shapes will only come with time, but it is easier than you think and the only time taking practice is to learn how to handle the needle.

Here are a few basics that will help you:

- You must prep your wool by tearing apart the roving you will need.
- Create a roving ball by tucking the ends in so that the roll doesn't get lost.
- Place the roving ball on the surface and start agitating it.
- Keep your finger out of the needle's path when poking or the extremely sharp needles could hurt you.
- You will see the bond starting to create a shape of your choice and forming the felt. As the ball will shrink your shape will come into existence more clearly.
