Vaibhav Mishra further said that to implement this scheme, a list of slum chiefs and cluster heads is being prepared and apart from this, local leaders associated with various political parties are also being sought, so that any slum areas should not be deprived of sanitation. There are more than 650 slum clusters in Delhi, in which more than 2 lakh families live. I hope that almost all the identified places will be sanitized within the next 2 months. The Sarkari helpline will bear the full expenditure of this work.
