While there, her subspecialty training placed an emphasis on cartilage restoration, ligament/tendon repair, and joint preserving surgical techniques of the foot and ankle, which allows patients to continue with their athletic careers and recreational activities.

During her fellowship at Virginia Mason Medical Center, Dr. Randall assisted the team physicians for the Seattle Seahawks(NFL), Seattle Storm(WNBA), and Seattle Sounders FC(MLS). She also serviced other sports teams, including multiple semi-professional universities and high school teams in basketball, football, and track and field.

An expert in bone work, with implants, fusions, or fractures, the doctor is board-certified in foot and ankle surgery by the American Board of Foot & Ankle Surgery, whose purpose is to protect and improve the health and welfare of the public by the advancement of the art and science of podiatric surgery.

Constantly educating herself with new methods and giving back by educating the next generation, Dr. Randall serves as an Adjunct Professor at Western University College of Health Sciences.
