A certified wound care specialist, he serves as an active member of the American Medical Association, the American College of Surgeons (Fellow), the Society for Vascular Surgery, the Eastern Vascular Society, the Wound Healing Society, the Medical Society of the State of New York, the Association for Academic Surgery, and the Suffolk County Medical Society.

A graduate of Baylor College of Medicine, Dr. Petersen went on to perform his residency in general surgery at Stony Brook University. He followed up with a fellowship in vascular surgery at Harvard University (Massachusetts General Hospital).

Passionate about enhancing patients' quality of life, the doctor is board-certified in vascular surgery and general surgery by the American Board of Surgery (ABS). The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Vascular surgery is a surgical subspecialty in which diseases of the vascular system, including the arteries, veins, and lymphatic circulation, are managed by medical therapy, minimally invasive catheter procedures, and surgical reconstruction. A vascular surgeon diagnoses treat, and manages conditions in the arteries and veins, also called the blood vessels. These specialists treat a range of health problems, from spider and varicose veins to life-threatening aneurysms, and can help patients manage chronic conditions throughout their lives.

Among Dr. Petersen's most notable achievements include Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2014, 2015, 2016, 2018) and the Patients' Choice Award (2014, 2015, 2018).
