With Smith's background as an engineer and a former professional athlete, he is uniquely equipped to provide both STEM content and advice for raising young athletes. The app features a segment for Dads, titled, "Don't Stop the Swagger," after a mindset coaching book he wrote by the same name in 2004.

Smith and his family had so much fun exploring that they've continued taking their homeschool lessons on the road. They are constantly on the lookout for new places with a rich history to share.

"The U.S. has a great deal of diversity in both landscape and culture," says Smith. "Considering the political climate of late, it's a good time to renew our understanding of what fills our country with greatness and hope.
