Dedicated to clinical excellence, the doctor is board-certified in family medicine by the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM). The ABFM is a non-profit, independent medical association of American physicians who practice in family medicine and its sub-specialties.

To boot, he is board-certified in addiction medicine by the American Board of Preventive Medicine, a member of the American Board of Medical Specialties that issues "certificates of special knowledge" in the specialty of preventive medicine.

Family medicine is a medical specialty devoted to comprehensive health care for people of all ages. The specialist is called a family physician or family doctor. A family physician is often the first person a patient sees when seeking healthcare services. They examine and treat patients with a wide range of conditions and refer those with serious ailments to a specialist or appropriate facility.

A recognized author, Dr. Cooke believes that everyone deserves the opportunity to equal access to hope, health, and opportunity. His book, Canary in the Coal Mine, explores this concept through the lens of the 2015 Scott County HIV outbreak.

Throughout his line of work, he has received national recognition for the quality and compassionate care he provides by being named Family Physician of the Year by the Indiana Academy of Family Physicians and the American Academy of Family Physicians. He has also received the Doc Hollywood Award by the Indiana Rural Health Association for his service to rural Indiana, the Indiana State Health Commission's Award for Exceptional Public Health Service, the Ryan White Distinguished Leadership Award, and the first-ever Physician Pillar of Excellence Award by Addiction Policy Forum.
