In Mumbai, there are around 4000 Ganpati Mandals & most of them use Ganesh murti made from Plaster of Paris. Every year the number of Ganesh Mandals in Mumbai, Maharashtra & India increases & so does the use of Plaster of Paris. Research says that nearly 90% of people use Ganesh murtis made from plaster of Paris.

If not taken seriously now, then in the future, things may even be worse. So to take care of our environment, strict measures need to be taken. Awareness regarding the use of eco-friendly Ganesh murti needs to spread among people. Environment-friendly idols are the best solution for this. In recent years there has been a significant increase in the use of eco-friendly murtis. Ganesh murtis made of Shadu & Paper mache are used by many people. Shadu murti is made from clay which is found in the Konkan region of Maharashtra. Other parts of the country use clay from other river banks. The main advantage is that Shadu idols dissolve quickly in the water compared to Plaster of Paris idols. Also, with Shadu idols, many use idols made from recycled paper. In 2019 Tejukaya Ganpati Mandal, a popular Ganesh Mandal in Mumbai had installed a 22 feet paper Ganesh murti. Many other Ganpati mandals are also now opting for eco-friendly Ganesh murtis.

For the past three years, Deep Ganesh Arts has taken the initiative to help people celebrate the Ganesh festival in an eco-friendly way by selling Ganesh murti made from Shadu. As Ganesh Chaturthi is approaching, many people will already have started to book Ganesh idols. But it is also necessary to take care of the environment along with the festivals and traditions.
