He graduated from UNTH as a registered nurse anesthetist in August of 1998. He went on from there to serve at the National Hospital (The Presidency), Abuja, Nigeria from late 1999 till May 2002 when he was selected by the Nigerian Technical Aid Corps to assist in providing healthcare in the nation of Belize. He came to the United States in July 2003. He literally started his nursing career from the very scratch all over again. He obtained his BSN from Texas Technical University (TTUHSCSON) with Magna Cum Laude in 2013. He later went on to earn his doctorate degree (to become an APRN) from Marshall University in May of 2019.

A Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) plays a crucial role in the success of a variety of medical/surgical procedures. They work in collaboration with professionals across the health spectrum: surgeons, anesthesiologists, dentists, podiatrists, and other professionals to ensure that patients are well prepared before the surgery, safe administration of anesthesia, excellent postoperative and follow-up care.

An Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) is a nurse who has obtained at least a master's degree in nursing. APRNs may work across various healthcare settings, including hospitals, ambulatory clinics, health insurance, or long-term care facilities. They provide medical support and preventive care to patients, along with additional responsibilities of coordinating patient care and using specialized knowledge to manage complex patient conditions. APRNs can diagnose and treat as well as order and interpret tests and prescribe medications.
