India Seeks To Attract Tourists By Half Million Free Tourist Visas



Delhi, New Delhi, Jul 6, 2021 (Issuewire.com) - The Indian Central government on Monday declared that India will presently offer India Tourist Visa liberated from any charge until March 31, 2022. The plan was reported by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman as a feature of a 6 Billion Dollar monetary help bundle for the Covid-19 disabled economy.
