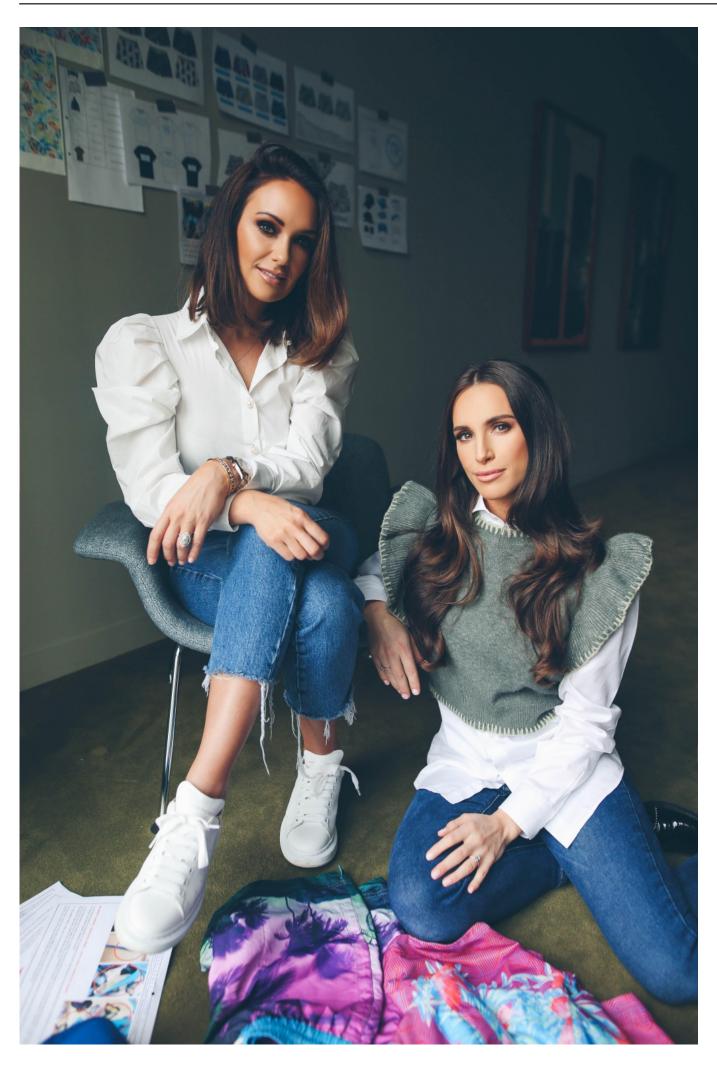
Meet the New Directors of Thomas Royall, the Luxury swimwear brand.
