
## Alan Garvin, MD, FACC, FACP, a Cardiologist with Valley Heart Institute of Doctors Medical Center

A Fellow of both the American College of Cardiology and the American College of Physicians, Dr. Garvin is the founding member of the American Society of Nuclear Cardiology. He is also a member of the Association of Black Cardiologists and the Society of Nuclear Medicine.

Cardiology is a branch of medicine that deals with disorders of the heart, as well as some parts of the circulatory system. The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).

An eminent leader in his field, Dr. Garvin has presented and published research on the causes of electrocardiography, planar, clinical, nuclear, and cardiac imaging, first-pass radionuclide ventriculography, and coronary artery disease. He has also traveled to Kenya, India, the Philippines, and Vietnam on a number of medical missions.
