To become board-certified physicians must pass rigorous examinations in each subspecialty, and maintain certification through recurrent testing, and participation in ongoing educational activities. This ensures that your physician achieving board certification is up to date on the newest treatment modalities.

Practicing medicine in South Carolina, Dr. Arthur is affiliated with Carolina Heart and Vascular Center and Aiken Regional Medical Centers.

Interventional cardiology is the subspecialty of cardiology that uses specialized catheter-based techniques to diagnose and treat coronary artery disease, vascular disease, structural heart disease, and congenital heart defects. An interventional cardiologist is a cardiologist with one to two years of additional education and training in diagnosing and treating cardiovascular disease as well as congenital (present at birth) and structural heart conditions through catheter-based procedures, such as angioplasty and stenting.
