The scholarships were implemented to honor Mr. Armstrong who had a dream of attending medical

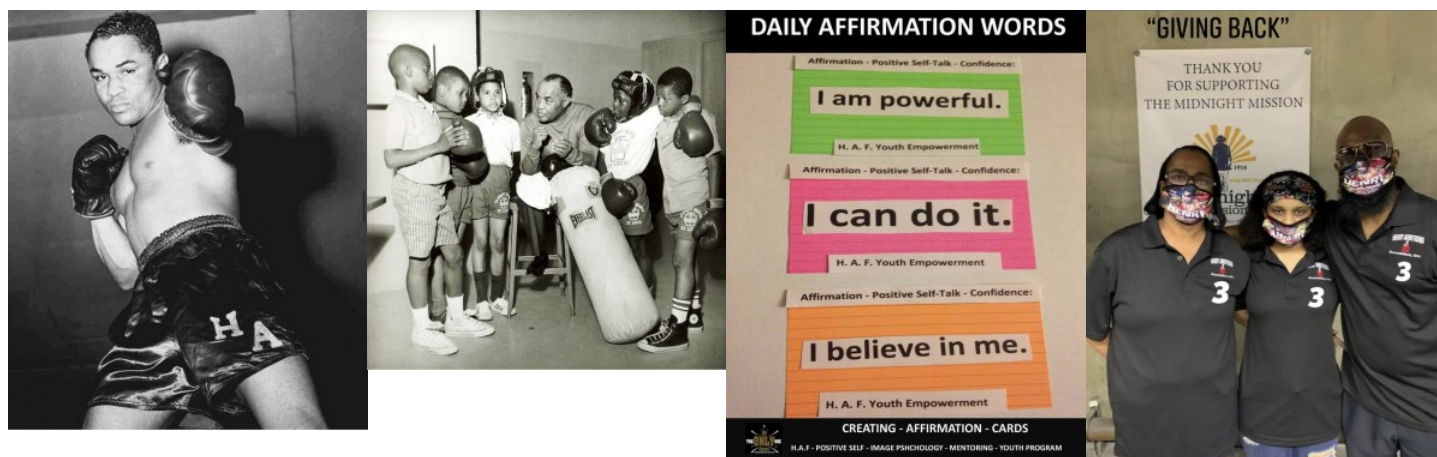
school but lacked the financial resources. As an alternative, he decided to pursue boxing as a career and rose to the top.
