ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

He has been awarded the honorary designations of Fellow of the American College of Critical Care Medicine and the American College of Chest Physicians.

An intensivist is a board-certified physician who provides special care for critically ill patients. Also known as a critical care physician, the intensivist has advanced training and experience in treating this complex type of patient. The intensivist has the primary responsibility for the ICU patient's care versus acting as a consultant, as many specialists do. In this role, he or she leads a team of caregivers who are experts in different specialties. The intensivist also oversees the many decisions involved in a critically ill patient's care and coordinates all the other services the patient may need – including those from specialists.
