The ABS is an independent, nonprofit organization founded in 1937 to provide board certification to individuals who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge in the field of surgery.

Furthermore, he is board-certified in thoracic surgery by the American Board of Thoracic Surgery, an American surgical organization devoted to surgery of the chest.

Licensed to practice medicine in Missouri, Dr. Stewart is affiliated with Truman Medical Center Hospital Hill and the Kansas City Veterans Affairs Medical Center.

In an effort to remain aware of changes in the field, he maintains his professional affiliation with the American College of Surgeons, the Society of Thoracic Surgeons, the Western Thoracic Surgical Association, and the Southern Thoracic Surgical Association.

Cardiothoracic surgery is the field of medicine involved in the surgical treatment of organs inside the chest. Cardiothoracic surgeons are medical doctors who specialize in surgical procedures inside the thorax, which may involve the heart, lungs, esophagus, and other organs in the chest. Alongside performing surgery, they also diagnose and treat diseases of these organs.

For his accomplishments in the field, Dr. Stewart has been named one of the Top Cardiothoracic Surgeons in the Country in 2006. Likewise, he has been presented awards from the University of Colorado, The John Hopkins Hospital, and the Virginia Surgical Society, among others, and attributes his professional success to the support and love of his patients.

Looking toward the future, Dr. Stewart plans to retire in the coming years. In his spare time, he enjoys fishing, golfing, and biking.
