Her medical expertise offers unique insights into the materials and fits that would be best for patient care. Some of her best ideas for products have come as solutions to parents' concerns.

Shortly after arriving in Austin, Dr. Sanchez established the Injury Free Coalition for Kids of Austin and became the lead physician for the Austin Safe Kids Coalition. Her firm belief in injury prevention gave birth to the first Injury Prevention program in Austin and the Children's Education and Community Resource Center. In 2006, her "Boost Now! Join the Buckleteers," a booster seat program to increase the usage of booster seats for children, received national recognition.
