Paulson, MD.

Delivering advanced care with a personal touch, she is board-certified in obstetrics and gynecology & reproductive endocrinology and infertility by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology (ABOG). The mission of the ABOG is to define specialty standards, certify obstetricians and gynecologists, and facilitate continuous learning to advance knowledge, practice, and professionalism in women's health.

Having previously served on the executive board for the Georgia Obstetrics and Gynecology Society, Dr. Fogle is an active member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society and the American Society for Reproductive Medicine.

In the state of Georgia, she is affiliated with Northside Hospital Atlanta and Northside Hospital Forsyth.

Reproductive endocrinology and infertility (REI) is a surgical subspecialty of obstetrics and gynecology that trains physicians in reproductive medicine addressing hormonal functioning as it pertains to reproduction, as well as the issue of infertility. While most REI specialists primarily focus on the treatment of infertility, reproductive endocrinologists are trained to also evaluate and treat hormonal dysfunctions in females and males outside after the reproductive years.

Recently named an Atlanta Top Doctor in the field of reproductive endocrinology, Dr. Fogle has received several awards for her research as a fertility specialist, including the Menopause Research Award and Val Davajan Fellow Award from the Pacific Coast Reproductive Society. Additionally, she has authored several peer-reviewed manuscripts in the field of reproductive endocrinology and infertility.
