What is FUE Hair Transplant?

FUE hair transplantation is usually done by extracting hair follicles from one part of an individual's scalp and moving them to another. In this case, the hair surgeon uses a micro punch to remove the follicular units one by one before relocating them.

In most cases, surgeons tend to ask patients for normal **FUE procedures**. However, if the issue matters, you may need to opt for a **bio-fue hair transplant**. It typically involves the fusion of traditional **FUE** with plasma therapy to stimulate stem cells.

Nevertheless, before proceeding with the **bio-FUE** hair transplant procedure, doctors extract highly concentrated plasma with growth factors from the blood. It helps to quickly grow both transplanted and residual hair.

How does the FUE transplant work?

The FUE hair transplant procedure consists of 5 steps:

• The **best FUE hair transplant** specialists begin the surgery by shaving the transplant site.

Then we will do the same with the section where the hair follicles are removed. This will make it easier to extract hair follicles from the core and perform **FUE hair transplant surgery**.

- Now start extracting hair follicles using the micro punch tool. It is performed after local anesthesia.
- With a needle, a series of small incisions are made in the graft area. It is considered the trickiest part of hair transplantation by **FUE technology**.
- After that, the **FUE hair transplant** surgeon begins to insert the hair follicle through the incision.
- At the end of the operation, the surgeon wipes the area with an antiseptic and bandages it to avoid bleeding or infection.
 - The success rate of FUE hair transplantation is quite high. About 70 to 90% of the transplanted hair follicles will work properly and you can expect to see significant amounts of hair growing.

The benefits of FUE hair transplantation

The main benefits of **FUE hair transplant surgery** include:

- Unlike FUT, **Karachi's FUE hair transplant** is somewhat less invasive. Therefore, there is no visible scarring at all.
- This method will help grow short hair at the site of the transplant. Therefore, it will be an ideal option for lovers of short hairstyles.
- One of the most striking benefits of **FUE hair transplantation** is that it is ideal and suitable for almost anyone.
- This allows the surgeon to implant a variety of grafts at once (nearly 5,000).
- FUE hair transplant surgery offers a natural outlook. It doesn't even cause trauma.
- The biostimulation FUE hair transplant method ensures tissue repair and promotes healing after the procedure.
