<u>NFTCalendar.wiki</u> helps NFT investors find the next NFT drop so they can purchase an NFT token at the launch price. Many NFT tokens will later appear on Opensea an eBay style auction site where NFT investors can list their inventory for sale to the highest bidder or fixes the price.
