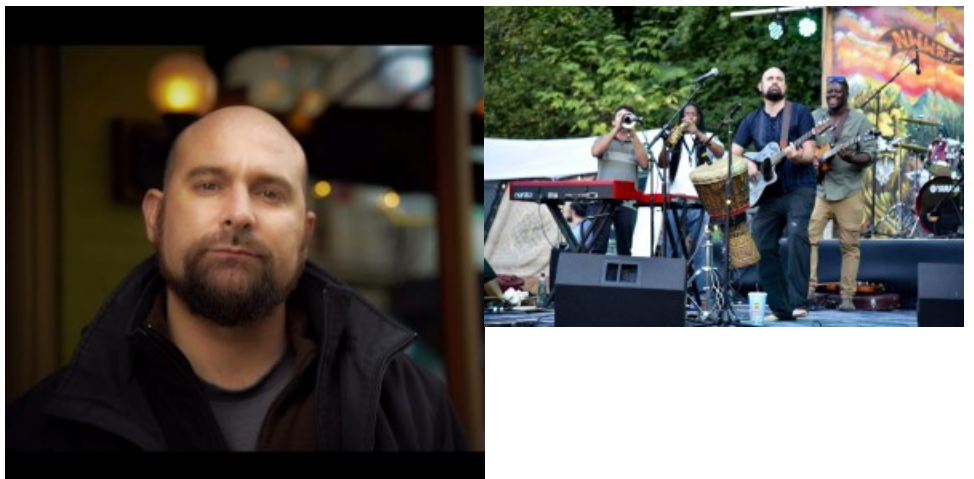

The lit candle illuminates our purpose in life in guiding and reminding us to who we truly are. Burning Incense inspires us to elevate every word, thought, and action. Bread is a symbol of unity, envisioning the oneness of life and coexistence with one another."

This World Citizen has created these sacred spaces as a headliner during the World Beat Festival which is one of the largest multicultural events in Oregon bringing over 25,000 visitors each year; on the main stage of Make Music Day that brings together a mass appeal of musicians and audiences from across the globe, and the Northwest World Reggae Festival with some of the best reggae artists from around the world.
