On a professional level, Dr. Leitman is a proud member of the Arthroscopy Association of North America, the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons, the Pennsylvania Orthopedic Society, the Philadelphia Orthopedic Society for Sports Medicine, and the Delaware Orthopaedic Society (Vice President).

In his professional experience, he serves as the Chairman of Orthopedics at Jennersville Regional Hospital and is affiliated with Christiana Care. In the past, he has been affiliated with Walter Reed Army Medical Center and the DeWitt Army Hospital, both while in the US Army Reserves, retiring with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. He has also served numerous Team Physician appointments, including seasons with the Philadelphia Eagles, Philadelphia Flyers, and Wilmington Blue Rocks.

Orthopedic surgery is the branch of surgery concerned with conditions involving the musculoskeletal system. Orthopedic surgeons use both surgical and non-surgical means to treat musculoskeletal trauma, spine diseases, sports injuries, degenerative diseases, infections, tumors, and congenital disorders.
