Maintaining fellowship status, Dr. Costouros is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS) and a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons (FAAOS).

In order to stay up to date in his field, he is an active member of the International Society of Arthroscopic, Knee Surgery, and Orthopedic Sports Medicine, the Arthroscopy Association of North America, the American Medical Association, the California Orthopedic Association, the California Medical Association, the Santa Clara County Medical Association, the Western Orthopedic Association, the Leroy C. Abbott Orthopedic Society (on the Board of Directors), and the European Society for Surgery of the Shoulder & Elbow.
