"Our mission is to lift communities by making learning more democratized, decentralized, and accessible. We don't want to leave anyone behind with our community microlearning technology. Aimee, to us, is doing the same thing. She's making sure no one gets left behind who's experienced a disability and that people of all abilities reach their human potential. That message really resonates here at Learnie," says Learnie co-Founder and Board member, Pete Mastin.

Learnie is redefining how people learn together. It delivers on-demand microlearning content that hones critical thinking capability and empowers life-long learning. In the coming months, Learnie will break ground on its revenue-generating content marketplace, further allowing content creators to "Share Their Knowledge & Earn Their Share" in the process.

Mastin continues saying this of the partnership, "We're very excited and honored to work with Aimee and have Learnie help her deliver on her mission. We believe learning is broken, and we're here to fix it in communities anchored by special organizations like Aimee's all across America."


