Rheumatologists deal mainly with immune-mediated disorders of the musculoskeletal system, soft tissues, autoimmune diseases, vasculitides, and inherited connective tissue disorders. Many of these diseases are now known to be disorders of the immune system. Rheumatology is considered to be the study and practice of medical immunology.

A Fellow of the American College of Rheumatology, Dr. Tokayer remains an active member of the American College of Rheumatology, the Florida Society of Rheumatology, and the Florida Medical Association. Outside his professional commitments, he is a volunteer with the local Arthritis Foundation's clinic for medically indigent arthritis patients.
