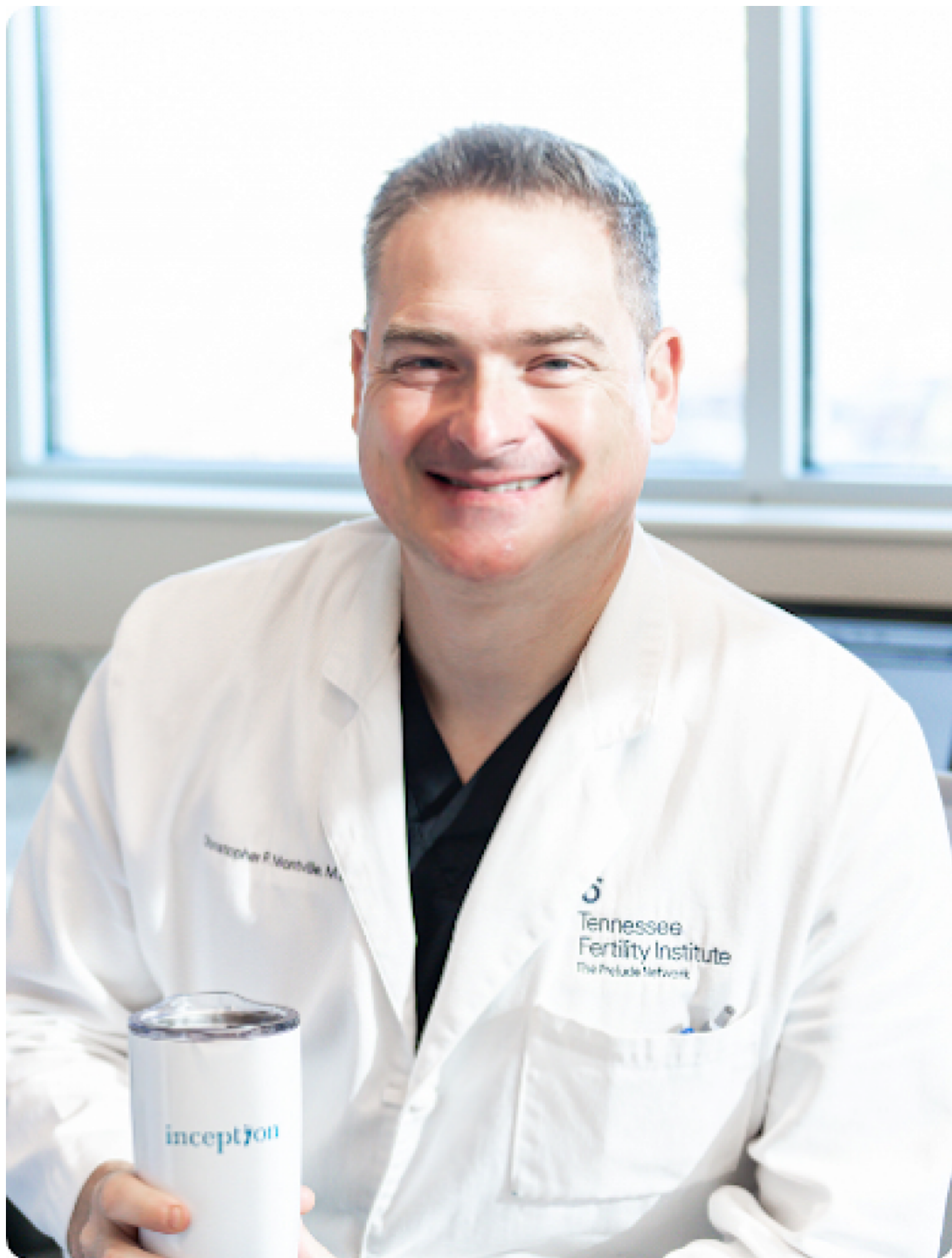


Christopher Montville, MD, a Reproductive Endocrinologist & Infertility Specialist with Tennessee Fertility Institute

He then went on to complete his internship and residency in obstetrics & gynecology at the University of Michigan Hospitals, and his fellowship in reproductive endocrinology & infertility at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine.

Subsequent to his education, the doctor attained board certification in reproductive endocrinology & infertility, and obstetrics & gynecology through the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology (ABOG). The mission of the ABOG is to define specialty standards, certify obstetricians and gynecologists, and facilitate continuous learning to advance knowledge, practice, and professionalism in women's health.

After completing his education and training, Dr. Montville moved to Montana where he developed and managed the first IVF and fertility-focused center in the state. It provided services to patients from a 500-mile radius who previously had no other fertility care options.

Reproductive endocrinology and infertility (REI) is a surgical subspecialty of obstetrics and gynecology that trains physicians in reproductive medicine addressing hormonal functioning as it pertains to reproduction, as well as the issue of infertility. While most REI specialists primarily focus on the treatment of infertility, reproductive endocrinologists are trained to also evaluate and treat hormonal dysfunctions in females and males after the reproductive years.
