While most REI specialists primarily focus on the treatment of infertility, reproductive endocrinologists are trained to also evaluate and treat hormonal dysfunctions in females and males after the reproductive years.

In addition to being a published author, researcher, and presenter, Dr. Nichols has obtained several awards over the years such as the Gamma Beta Phi Honor Society, the Merck Manual Award (given to those who graduated at the top ten percent of their class).
