Steps To Apply To DU SOL

Here are some crucial steps to apply online for Admission in DU SOL:

- First of all, students browse the official website of DU SOL (sol.du.ac.in)

- After hitting on the link, fill in all the required fields with your basic information and submit the form by hitting on the submitting button.

Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility criteria to get admission in the DUSOL, a student must have 50% aggregate marks in their 12th board. Students from any stream can apply for these particular distanced courses.
