The two-person teams will set out to solve a series of clues peppered throughout the city and have 12 hours to complete the race. Clues will range from monuments and historical sites to local pubs, parks, and photo clues. The first team to solve all of the clues will be deemed the Grand Prize winners and take home a whopping \$25,000.

"Chi-Town boasts exciting places to explore like the historic Sears tower, the Magnificent Mile, and Lincoln Park Zoo – this is a scavenger's heaven! What better place to jump off a one-of-a-kind competition than a town with 5 miles of Pedway and iconic double-decked streets. The city which is the birthplace of Walt Disney and home of the Bulls is ripe for a competition of this magnitude," adds Commissioner Brindza.

Each tournament is limited to 1,000 teams. Registrants must be 18 years or older. Future tournaments are planned throughout the U.S. including Milwaukee, Los Angeles, Indianapolis, St. Louis, Austin, and Denver.
