

## ORR receives \$1000 FFA grant from VALENT U.S.A. LLC to pursue AGRIBUSINESS SAE

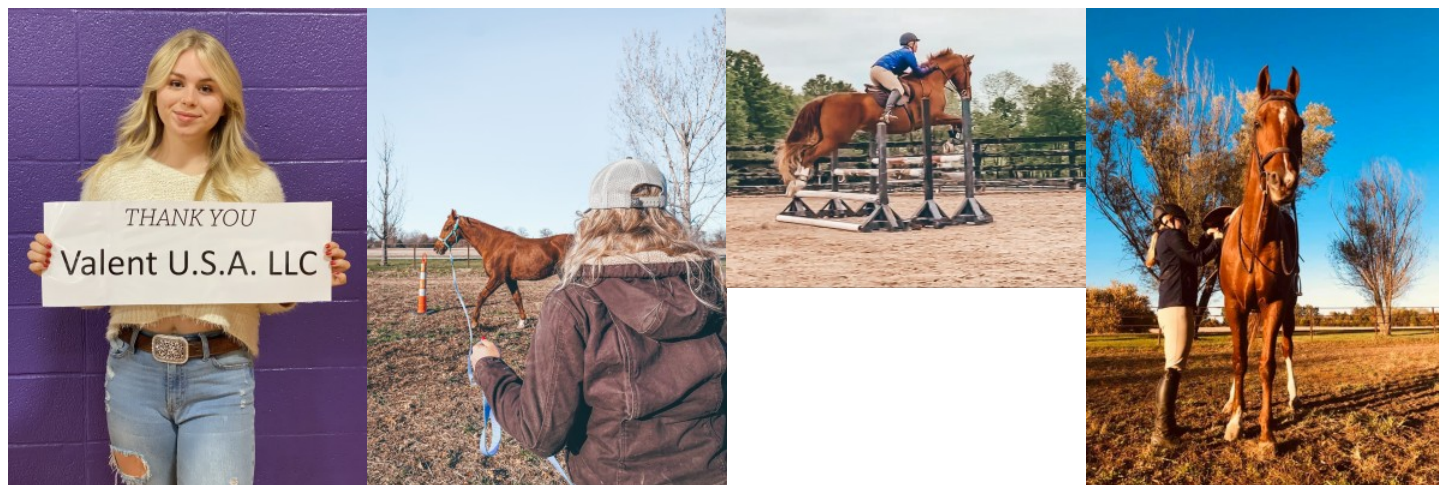


**Columbia, Missouri Jan 20, 2022 ([Issuewire.com](http://Issuewire.com))** - ROSELYNN ORR, a Hallsville High School sophomore, has been awarded a \$1000 FFA grant from VALENT USA LLC that will be utilized in the development of an equine training application that will integrate veterinary records and exercise prescriptions into periodization programs for sport horses. The application is projected to be available to both apple and android devices by September 2022.

SAE grants are designed to help FFA members create or expand Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) projects, a requirement that all FFA members must complete. An SAE requires FFA members to create and operate an agriculture-related business, work at an agriculture-related business or conduct an agricultural research experience. Upon completion, FFA members must submit a comprehensive report regarding their career development experience.
